TODAY 3-4pm Chapel! Learn about "The Last Flight of the Leaky Tub"

The Rev. Dr. Jim Corl will make a presentation about his family's trip to Austria last October for the dedication of a memorial for the crew of an American B-24 bomber that was shot down on February 23, 1944. His mother's youngest brother was a crew member and lost his life in the crash. The presentation will tell the story of SSgt Kenneth G. King and the crew of the B-24 bomber, the Leaky Tub, that was lost in action that day, and will tell the story of the crew memorial established at the crash site by the local Austrian community as a means to bring peace between former enemies. This is a great story for any veterans or families of veterans.
