A little bit about Justin: Justin Oei (pronounced We), is a graduate of the College of William & Mary in Williamsburg, Virginia, with a Bachelor of Arts in Music and will be moving to Syracuse in August to begin his Master of Music in Organ Performance at Syracuse University's Setnor School of Music. A native of New Jersey, Justin led the music ministries for Canterbury, the Episcopal Church at William & Mary for three years, played weekly services at historic Bruton Parish Church, and served as the Organist at Our Saviour's Lutheran Church in Norge, Virginia.
