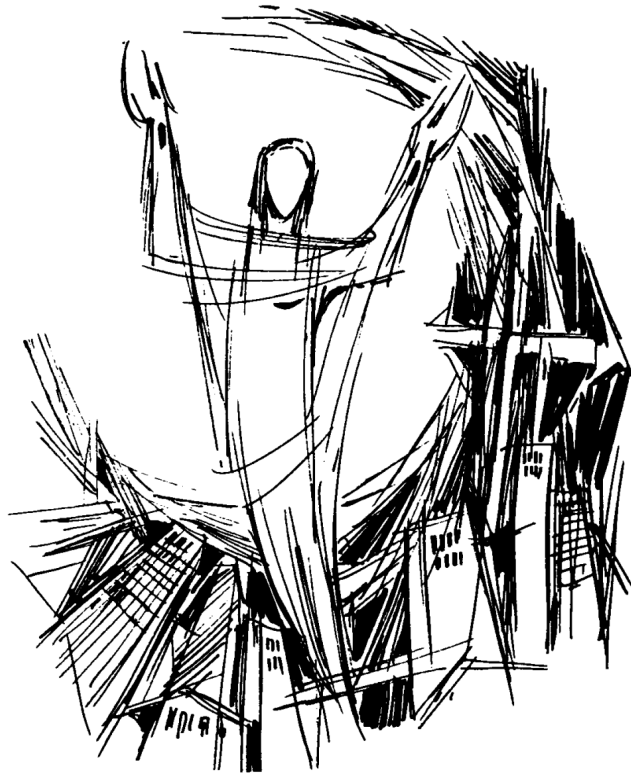

## The Sermon

The Rev. Joe T. Mitchell

**Creed** *(spoken)*

**All** We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, seen and unseen.

We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father, God from God, Light from light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, of one Being with the Father. Through him all things were made. For us and for our salvation he came down from heaven: by the power of the Holy Spirit he became incarnate from the Virgin Mary and was made man. For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate; he suffered death and was buried. On the third day he rose again in accordance with the Scriptures; he ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead, and his kingdom will have no end.

We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son. With the Father and the Son he is worshipped and glorified. He has spoken through the Prophets. We believe in one holy catholic and apostolic Church. We acknowledge one baptism for the forgiveness of sins. We look for the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.

*After recalling Christ's Last Supper, the Presider and People pray:*

*Presider* Great is the Mystery of Faith:  
*All* **Christ has died. Christ is risen. Christ will come again.**

*The Presider prays that the gifts and People may be blessed and sanctified by God. When the Presider concludes the prayer, the People loudly respond, "AMEN!"*

*Presider* And now, let us pray the prayer our Lord Jesus taught us:  
*All* **Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy Name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory, for ever and ever. Amen.**

*The Presider breaks the consecrated Bread. A period of silence is kept.*

*Presider* Alleluia! Christ our Passover is sacrificed for us.

*People* **Therefore let us keep the feast. Alleluia!**

*The Presider invites the People to share in the Communion of our Lord. All who desire a deeper relationship with Christ are welcome to receive. If you do not wish to receive, you may come forward for a Blessing.*

*Please move along your side of the aisle. Receive the Bread from the Presider or Deacon. If you wish to drink from the Cup, consume the Bread and move down to the next Minister. To have intinction, keep the Bread flat in your hand and move down to the next Minister, who will dip the Bread in the Wine and place it back in your hand. Return to your seat along the side aisles.*

*Gluten-free wafers are available upon request. If you do not wish to receive for any reason, you are welcome to come forward and cross your arms for a blessing. During Communion, Prayer Ministers are available at either end of the altar rail to pray with anyone who is in need.*

*People* **Loving God, we give you thanks for restoring us in your image and nourishing us with spiritual food in the Sacrament of Christ's Body and Blood.
